

Champagne & Sparkling Wine

- 1) Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene Extra Dry, Italy** £19
This fine, fruity Prosecco reveals hints of apples and pineapples. ABV 11%.
- 2) Cava Calamino Rose, Spain** £17
Well balanced and smooth, offering ripe plum, banana and nuts! ABV 12%.
- 3) De Telmont Grande Réserve, Champagne, France** £30
Medium bodied, with apple and lemon fruit flavours and a classically yeasty style. ABV 12%.
- 4) Veuve Clicquot, Champagne, France** £45
A gorgeous but deceptively pale colour with fine persistent bubbles – an archetypal Champagne from an historic house. ABV 12%.
- 5) Bollinger Special Cuvée, Champagne, France** £50
A full-bodied champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent. ABV 12%.

White Wine

Complex & Elegant

- 6) Tin Roof Chardonnay 2008, South Eastern Australia** £15
A soft buttery chardonnay, with a smooth taste and a rich fruity finish. ABV 13% (2).

- 7) Alain Grignon Viognier 2008, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France** £18
This richly flavoured wine offers aromas of flora, apricots and peaches. ABV 12.5% (1).
- 8) Pouilly-Fuissé Terroirs de Fuissé Sélection 2008, Christophe Cordier, France** £30
This wine, part fermented in oak barrels. displays a richness balanced by tropical pineapple flavours and crisp citrus acidity. ABV 13.5% (1).
- 9) Mâcon-Lugny 2008, Louis Latour, Burgundy, France** £22
Louis Latour is one of the top names in Burgundy and this sophisticated wine has a well defined buttery lemon bouquet and crisp fruit flavours. ABV 13% (1).

Fresh & Aromatic

- 10) Neblina Sauvignon Blanc 2009, Central Valley, Chile** £15
Youthful, lively and fresh, this sauvignon blanc has herbal tropical notes on the nose followed by a zesty citrus palate. ABV 12.5% (1).

- 11) Sancerre 2008, Roger Neveu, Loire Valley, France** £24
Beautifully balanced and supremely refined with a grassy aromatic fruit character and a lively tangy finish. ABV 12% (1).
- 12) Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc 2009, Marlborough, New Zealand** £22
An outstanding wine with a fruity palate and a lasting, refreshing finish. ABV 13% (1).
- 13) Boar's Kloof Chenin Blanc 2009, Riebeek Valley, South Africa** £15
Crisp aromatic fruit, fresh and lively with zingy vibrant acidity and a clean dry finish. ABV 13% (1).

Light & Crisp

14) Vina Adela Vino Blanco, Bodegas Aldeanueva, Spain **£13**
Made from the viura grape, a key rioja varietal, it has fresh aromas and crisp zingy acidity, perfect with seafood and white meats. ABV 11.5% (3).
Also available by the glass: **£3.25** 175ml **£4.35** 250ml

15) Chablis 2008, Jean Bourguignon, Burgundy, France **£22**
This is a lively and fresh chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character. The perfect accompaniment for white fish. ABV 11.5% (1).

16) Pinot Grigio Malandrino 2008, Italy **£15**
Made using 100% pinot grigio, this wine displays notes of citrus fruits, with a hint of floral aromas. ABV 12% (1).

Rosé Wine

17) Bois des Violettes 2008, Van de Pays d'Oc, France **£15**
Wonderfully fresh with an intense aroma of violet and lychees. The palate is youthful, juicy, rich and well balanced. ABV 12% (2).

18) Whispering Hills White Zinfandel Rose 2009, California, USA **£15**
A deep salmon pink wine bursting with fresh summer fruit flavours. ABV 11% (4).

19) Château Saint Roch-lès-Vignes 2009, Rosé, Provence, France **£21**
A delicious rosé showing soft spice and attractive fruit from this top winery in St. Tropez. Its luxurious origins are proven in the tasting. ABV 13% (2).

Red Wine

Full & Velvety

20) Chianti Loggia Del Conte 2008, Le Chiantigiane, Italy **£18**
Made from the sangiovese and canaiolo grapes, this wine has delightful aromas of cherries and violets and youthful red fruit flavours on the palate. ABV 12.5% (C).

21) Tin Roof Shiraz Cabernet 2009, South Eastern Australia **£15**
A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours in an easy drinking style. ABV 13.5% (C).
Also available by the glass: **£3.75** 175ml **£4.95** 250ml

22) Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Cuvée des Antiques' 2008, Rhône Valley, France **£30**
Aged in the famous cellars of Ogier Caves des Papes, this wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear with a smooth lingering finish. ABV 14.5% (D).

23) Barolo "Galarej" Fontanafredda 2004, Italy **£30**
This is a robust, full bodied wine packed with structure. The bouquet is clean, full and intense, with the typical Barolo characteristics of wild roses and tar. ABV 12.5% (D).

24) Otterbrook Mill 2009, Shiraz, Australia **£18**
A lovely, smooth wine showing notes of plum and dark berry fruits with a delicate, spicy finish. ABV 13.5% (C).

Lively & Fruity

25) Vina Adela Vino Rosso, Bodegas Aldeanueva, Spain **£13**

This tempranillo/garnacha blend is well balanced with the aroma of summer fruits, ripe cherries and redcurrant flavours that persist on the finish, rounded by soft tannins. ABV 13% (C).

26) Pinot Noir La Grille 2007, Loire Valley, France **£18**

A medium-bodied Pinot Noir with soft juicy fruit and lovely crisp finish. Try it chilled for summer drinking. ABV 12% (C).

27) Brouilly 2007, Domaine des Maisons Neuves, Beaujolais, France **£22**

An elegant wine from the greatest Beaujolais vintage on record delivering rich fruit intensity and a smooth, mouth-watering palate. ABV 13% (C).

28) Fairleigh Estate Pinot Noir 2008, Marlborough, New Zealand **£24**

Hand harvested from vines on the southern side of the Wairau Valley, this is a classic pinot. Delicious berry fruit and subtle spicy aromas with well balanced tannins. ABV 13.5% (C).

29) Bantry Bay Pinotage 2009, South Africa **£18**

Soft and rounded with a hint of brambles! ABV 14% (C).

30) Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Cave Co-op de Buxy 2007, Burgundy, France **£20**

An excellent pinot noir with soft berry flavours with a rounded structure and smooth tannins. ABV 13% (C).

Round & Smooth

31) Gestos Malbec/Malbec 2008, Finca Flichman, Mendoza, Argentina **£19**

50% of this stunning malbec comes from vineyards at 700m above sea level (this fruit gives the ripe plum and prune characteristics) and 50% coming from 1,100m (where the grapes mature more slowly giving intense colour and aromatics). ABV 14% (D).

32) Torre Aldea Rioja 2007, Spain **£18**

A deep, bright red cherry colour with a persistent aroma of ripe fruit and red berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a pleasant after taste. ABV 13% (C).

33) Casa Roca Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2009, Central Valley, Chile **£15**

A medium bodied wine with ripe red and black fruits and a soft finish. ABV 13% (D).

Also available by the glass: **£3.75** 175ml **£4.95** 250ml

34) Château du Monthyl 2003, Médoc, Bordeaux, France **£22**

A classic Médoc, rich in colour and bouquet, the harmonious palate shows perfect balance between ripe red fruit flavours and well integrated tannins. ABV 12.5% (C).

35) Bacaro Sangiovese Rubicone IGT 2008, Italy **£15**

This medium bodied wine has a pleasant, fresh bouquet with an aroma of dark cherries and plums. Very easy on the palate with light tannins and a smooth finish. ABV 12% (C).

36) Fitou Mont Tauch 2007, Les Hauts de Montluzy, Fitou, France **£18**

Mont Tauch is Fitou's leading producer. This superb example has a defined structure with a rich core of savoury black fruit. ABV 13% (C).

Welsh & Welsh Connected Wines

The Bell offers two wines that have been grown and bottled in Wales. The Glyndwr vineyard at Cowbridge in the Vale of Glamorgan has 6000 vines producing a small range of acclaimed wines. The vineyard was established in 1982 by Richard and Susan Norris.

37) Glyndwr Aromatic Medium White 2006, Madeleine Agnevine/Seyval Blanc, Wales £22
A refreshing and light wine with floral overtones. ABV 10% (3).

38) Glyndwr Sparkling Rose Vintage 2006, Rondo/Seyval Blanc, Wales £30
A "method champenoise" sparkling rose with delicious cherry undertones. ABV 11.5%.

In 1865, 153 Welsh settlers arrived in the Chabut Valley, Patagonia, Argentina. The colony was highly successful and the Welsh Argentine community now numbers over 20,000 of whom over 2000 are native Welsh speakers. We have sourced a chardonnay and a malbec from this region.

39) Valle De Perdido Chardonnay 2008, Patagonia, Argentina £25
Light tropical fruit flavours, a streak of refreshing lemon tang and just a hint of oak. ABV 14% (1).

40) Valle De Perdido Malbec 2007, Patagonia, Argentina £25
Rich, ripe, juicy and glossy black fruit with hints of toasted coffee beans and a robust finish. ABV 14% (D).

Welshman Bob Watts acquired Château du Seuil in Bordeaux, France in 1989. The estate is now managed by his daughter and they are producing highly acclaimed wines. We have sourced a sauvignon blanc and a cabernet sauvignon merlot from Château du Sueil.

41) Domaine Du Seuil, Semillion Sauvignon Blanc 2007, Bordeaux, France £26
A zesty white with honey overtones and lots of green fruit. ABV 12% (1).

42) Domaine Du Seuil, Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2004, Bordeaux, France £26
The ripest fruits are picked to give a deep intense colour that takes on a brick-red tinge with age. Soft tannins give a a long fine aftertaste. ABV 13% (D).

We have sourced an excellent wine whose Welsh accreditation extends merely to originating from New South Wales, Australia!

43) Margan Cabernet Sauvignon 2008, Hunter Valley, New South Wales, Australia £30
An intense wine of deep purple colour. Wild berries, herbs, subtle oak and a full long finish. ABV 14.5% (D).
