

Champagne & Sparkling Wine

- 1) Prosecco di Conegliano Valdobbiadene Extra Dry, Italy** £19
This fine, fruity Prosecco reveals hints of apples and pineapples. Ideal as an apéritif or with light food. ABV 11%.
- 2) Cava Calamino Rose, Spain** £16
Well balanced and smooth, offering ripe plum and banana with notes of toast and nuts.
- 3) De Telmont Grande Réserve, Champagne, France** £30
Medium bodied, with apple and lemon fruit flavours and a classically yeasty style. ABV 12%.
- 4) Veuve Clicquot, Champagne, France** £40
A gorgeous but deceptively pale colour with fine persisant bubbles – an archetypal Champagne from an historic house. ABV 12%.
- 5) Bollinger Special Cuvée, Champagne, France** £50
A full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in colour, the mousse is light and persistent. ABV 12%.

White Wine

Complex & Elegant

- 6) Coldridge Estate Chardonnay 2007, South Eastern Australia** £14
This classic Australian Chardonnay offers fresh ripe fruit characters, with a soft yet flavoursome butterscotch finish. ABV 13% (2).

- 7) Alain Grignon Viognier 2008, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France** £16
This richly flavoured wine offers aromas of flora, apricots and white peaches. ABV 12.5% (1).
- 8) Pouilly-Fuissé Terroirs de Fuissé Sélection 2007, Christophe Cordier, France** £30
This wine has undergone a traditional vinification with half the wine fermented in oak barrels. The richness is balanced by tropical pineapple flavours and crisp citrus acidity. ABV 13.5% (1).
- 9) Waimea Estate Pinot Gris 2008, Nelson, New Zealand** £22
Bursting with aromas of pear, honey, candied apple, spice and even a hint of cream, the intensity of pure fruit flavours is complimented by clean acidity, good length and soft texture. ABV 14.5% (1).
- 10) Mâcon-Lugny 2007, Louis Latour, Burgundy, France** £20
Louis Latour is one of the top names in Burgundy and this sophisticated wine has a well defined buttery lemon bouquet and crisp fruit flavours. ABV 13% (1).

Fresh & Aromatic

11) Neblina Sauvignon Blanc 2008, Central Valley, Chile £15
Youthful, lively and fresh, this Sauvignon Blanc has herbal tropical notes on the nose, followed by a zesty citrus palate. ABV 12.5% (1).
Also available by the glass: £3.75 175ml £4.95 250ml

12) Sauvignon de Touraine 2008, Domaine de La Prévôté, Loire Valley, France £18
A delicate wine exhibiting flinty minerally tones with a crisp lemon bite. Beautifully balanced and rounds off to a long and elegant finish. ABV 12% (1).

13) Sancerre 2007, Roger Neveu, Loire Valley, France £24
Beautifully balanced and supremely refined with grassy aromatic fruit character and a lively tangy finish. ABV 12% (1).

14) Fairleigh Estate Sauvignon Blanc 2008, Marlborough, New Zealand £17
Ripe, lemony and zesty with an exquisite bouquet of elderflower and fresh gooseberries and a long mouth-watering finish. ABV 13% (1).

Light & Crisp

15) Marques Calado Macabeo 2008, Cariñena, Spain £12
Fresh, floral aromas reminiscent of aromatic herbs such as anise and fennel, the smooth and velvety palate is fruit driven with citrus and banana characteristics. ABV 13% (2).
Also available by the glass: £3.00 175ml £4.25 250ml

16) Robertson Winery Chenin Blanc 2008, South Africa £14
A pleasant easy drinking wine, with honey sweet aromas and ripe apricot fruit, balanced by zest of grapefruit for an off dry finish. ABV 12.5% (1).

17) Chablis 2008, Jean Bourguignon, Burgundy, France £22
This is a lively and fresh Chablis with clean citrus aromas. Crisp and fruity on the palate with a good steely character. The perfect for accompanying meaty white fish. ABV 11.5% (1).

18) Pinot Grigio Malandrino 2008, Italy £15
Made using 100% Pinot Grigio this wine displays notes of citrus fruits, with a hint of floral aromas. ABV 12% (1).

Rosé Wine

19) Cuvée des Amandiers Rosé 2008, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France £14
A fresh jammy Rosé giving a wonderful dark pink colour with opulent strawberry and cherry fruits on the palate. ABV 12% (2).
Also available by the glass: £3.50 175ml £4.75 250ml

20) Château Saint Roch-lès-Vignes 2008, Rosé, Provence, France £19
A delicious rosé showing soft spice and attractive fruit from this top winery in St. Tropez. Its luxurious origins are proven in the tasting. ABV 13% (2).

Dessert Wine

21) Clos L'Abeilley, Sauternes, France (375cl) £20
A superb Sauternes with excellent botrytis characteristics exhibiting wild honey aromas, luscious apricot fruit and a great length.

Red Wine

Full & Velvety

- 22) Chianti Loggia Del Conte 2007, Le Chiantigiane, Italy** £16
Made from the Sangiovese and Canaiolo grapes, this wine has delightful aromas of cherries and violets and youthful red fruit flavours on the palate. ABV 12.5% (C).
- 23) Tin Roof Shiraz Cabernet 2008, South Eastern Australia** £14
A soft fruity red with ripe berry fruit and gentle spicy flavours in an easy drinking style. ABV 13.5% (C).
Also available by the glass: £3.50 175ml £4.75 250ml
- 24) Châteauneuf-du-Pape 'Cuvée des Antiques' 2007, Rhône Valley, France** £30
Aged in the famous cellars of Ogier Caves des Papes, this wine is dark ruby with a complex nose of spices and hints of pear with a smooth and lingering finish. ABV 14.5% (D).
- 25) Mount Langi Ghiran 'Billi Billi Creek' Shiraz 2004, Victoria, Australia** £19
An exceptional wine from an up-and-coming producer delivering rich black fruit flavours and distinctive black pepper characters. ABV 14% (D).
- 26) Barolo "Galarej" Fontanafredda 2004, Italy** £30
This is a robust, full bodied wine packed with structure. The bouquet is clean, full and intense, with typical Barolo characteristics of wild roses and tar. ABV 12.5% (D).
- 27) La Réserve de Léoville-Barton 2004, St Julien, Bordeaux, France** £40
The second wine of Château Leoville-Barton. Grapes are hand-picked and fermented in large oak vats. The wine is concentrated but elegant, with ripe fruits and delicate perfume – a claret of true class. ABV 13% (C).

Lively & Fruity

- 28) Marques Calado Tempranillo 2008, Cariñena, Spain** £12
Classic notes of dark cherry and blackcurrant are lifted by a hint of dried flowers and sweet spice. Superbly balanced, the fruit flavours are perfectly complemented by soft tannins. ABV 13% (C).

- 29) Pinot Noir La Grille 2007, Loire Valley, France** £16
A medium-bodied Pinot Noir with soft juicy fruit and lovely crisp finish. Try it chilled for summer drinking. ABV 12% (C).
- 30) Brouilly 2007, Domaine des Maison Neuves, Beaujolais, France** £20
An elegant wine from the greatest Beaujolais vintage on record delivering rich fruit intensity and a smooth, mouth-watering palate. ABV 13% (C).
- 31) Fairleigh Estate Pinot Noir 2007, Marlborough, New Zealand** £24
Hand harvested from vines on the southern side of the Wairau Valley, this is a classic Kiwi Pinot. Delicious berry fruit and subtle spicy aromas with well balanced tannins. ABV 13.5% (C).
- 32) Ravenswood Lodi Zinfandel 2006, California** £21
Mature vines lend this sumptuous Zinfandel its character, bursting with concentrated blueberry and plums with notes of vanilla and toasted spices that linger on the finish. ABV 14.5% (D).
- 33) Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Cave Co-op de Buxy 2007, Burgundy, France** £19
An excellent Pinot Noir with soft berry flavours with a rounded structure and smooth tannins. ABV 13% (C).

Round & Smooth

34) Gestos Malbec/Malbec 2007, Finca Flichman, Mendoza, Mendoza, Argentina **£18**

50% of this stunning Malbec comes from vineyards at 700m above sea level (this fruit gives the ripe plum and prune characteristics) and 50% coming from 1,100m (where the grapes mature more slowly giving intense colour and aromatics). ABV 14% (D).

35) Torre Aldea Rioja 2007, Spain **£16**

A deep, bright red cherry colour with a persistent aroma of ripe fruit and red berries. Long and lingering with great harmony and a pleasant aftertaste. ABV 13% (C).

36) Neblina Merlot 2008, Central Valley, Chile **£15**

On the nose rich notes of plum and blackberries lifted by Chocolate and Mocha. Silky yet structured with concentrated fruit flavours. ABV 12.5% (C).

37) Château du Monthyl 2003, Médoc, Bordeaux, France **£22**

A classic Médoc, rich in colour and bouquet, the harmonious palate shows perfect balance between ripe red fruit flavours and well integrated tannins. ABV 12.5% (C).

38) Bacaro Sangiovese Rubicone IGT 2008, Italy **£13**

This medium bodied wine has a pleasant, fresh bouquet with aromas of dark cherry and plum. Very easy on the palate with light tannins and a smooth finish. ABV 12% (C).

39) Fitou Mont Tauch 2007, Les Hauts de Montluzy, Fitou, France **£16**

Mont Tauch is Fitou's leading producer. This superb example has a defined structure with a rich core of savoury black fruit. ABV 13% (C).
